Treasurer's Report

- Amy Moore reported that, as of the end of the 2017-18 school year, the PG account balance was approximately \$39,000.
- Mrs. Grabarkiewicz, assistant principal, then reported on how the PG funds were reinvested into the school over the summer on several capital expenditures, such as building improvements and technology for students and teachers including:
 - 10 new Promethean Boards were purchased for classrooms, including some of the younger grades.
 - Chromebooks were purchased to assist students with reading.
 - Tablets were purchased for each of the junior high school students (7th and 8th grades).
 - A network drop was installed for improved wireless connectivity for the teachers.
 - Flooring and lockers were renovated in the halls and classrooms on the lower level.
 - o New sound-dampening boards were installed in the cafeteria.

Fundraising

- There are four major fundraisers throughout the year
 - First Day School Supplies Melissa Celani noted that \$500 was raised, and it is
 the convenience for families to have all the school supplies shipped to the school
 and waiting in each child's classroom, that is the appeal of this fundraiser.
 - Little Caesars Pizza Kits Melissa also reported that the PG will sell Little Caesars Pizza Kits again this year, but the timing is likely to change. Last year, this fundraiser raised approx. \$1,500 for the school.
 - Holiday Boutique This is the largest fundraiser for DCES, which raised approx. \$25,000 for the school last year. This is Erika Laszlo's last year as the chairperson this event. A new chairperson is needed to step into that role – to shadow Erika this year and to chair the event next year. If anyone is interested, please contact Erika at ellaszlo@gmail.com.
 - Better Made Potato Chips Kelly Geresy reported that approx. \$4,200 in profit
 was raised from the Better Made Chips fundraiser. Kelly made an appeal for

Book Bank
